Back to School Sales Tax Holiday

<u>Description:</u> By state law, the sales tax holiday begins on the first Friday in August and continues through the following Sunday. In 2016, this is Friday, Aug. 5 through Sunday, Aug. 7. Certain back-to-school purchases, such as clothing, school supplies, computers, are exempt from sales tax for this time period!

The dumpsters are paid for from RGNA dues and are for the benefit of RGNA members. Non-members will be asked to make a donation to the neighborhood association

IMPORTANT REMINDER ON PROHIBITED ITEMS:

NO: tires, electronics – including TVs, computers/computer monitors, hazardous materials - including paint (paint cans must be completely washed out), pesticides, oil, or other chemicals, appliances with hazardous materials (example – dehumidifiers). Business/Commercial waste is also not accepted.

New - Goodwill Donation Collection: In a collaboration with Goodwill of Western Missouri & Eastern Kansas a donation truck will also be available during the Dumpster Day event.*

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Accessories - jewelry, belts, shoes, pocketbooks, scarves, ties, hats

Linens - blankets, sheets, towels, curtains, drapes

Housewares - dishes, silverware, pots, baskets, tins, glassware (package carefully)

Books--but no textbooks, encyclopedias or Reader's Digest Small electronics --Stereos (no consoles), computers, monitors, printers, toasters, irons

Toys

Electronics-clock radios, tape players, mp3 players, speakers

Lamps & Furniture - but no rusty, stained or worn areas Mechanical items - bikes, lawnmowers, weed whackers Records, tapes, CDs

Fabric, sewing supplies,

NOT ACCEPTED ITEMS

Large appliances - stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, dishwashers, TVs, console stereos Exercise Equipment

Mattresses and box springs Auto parts - tires, batteries Venetian blinds, curtain rods

Magazines Wire hangers

Building materials

Hazardous chemicals, paint, solvent, oil Baby Items –car seats, high chairs, playpens

*Goodwill representatives make the final decision on what is acceptable. Items are no longer repaired.
