In addition to not leaving the car unattended while it's warming and keeping the garage door closed, see below for a few ways to discourage criminal offenses and keep you're Amazon packages safe:

- Designate a "safe place" for deliveries- i.e. covered porch, bushes, behind the door
- Require a signature upon delivery
- Forward packages to Fedex, UPS, or USPS (and hope you get to the Brookside branch before it closes)
- Opt for In-store pick up (great opportunity to get something you forgot to "add to cart")
- Coordinate with a neighbor to bring in packages sitting on doorstep
