Oct. 26 & Nov. 30

Place on the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the regularly-scheduled trash day.  
 Use only paper lawn debris sacks. No plastic bags.  
 Use masking tape to seal the sacks; No plastic or duct tape.  
 No grass clippings. No trash.  
 All branches must be bundled.  
 Use twine or jute rope to tie bundles; do not use wire or plastic tape.
