## **Tips for Holiday Packages**

If possible, avoid having packages delivered to your house when you're not there.

Here are some additional tips:

- If your employer will allow it, have packages delivered to your office.
- If not, have packages delivered to a place where they can be received in person, such as the home of a trusted neighbor who stays home during the day, or a retired relative.
- Request the shipper require a signature confirmation or hold your package at their pick-up facility
- If purchasing from a large retailer, deliver to a local branch of the store
- Request a specific delivery date and time from the shipper when you know you will be home.
- Provide delivery instructions to the shipper to leave the package out of sight from the street.
- Sign up for delivery alerts from the shipper.

You may lose some of the convenience, but you still have your package!
