A party where each course is eaten at a different host's house in the same evening.

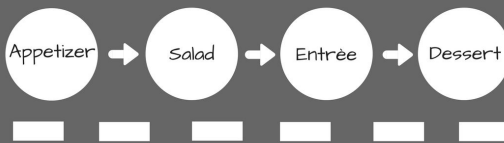
Every participant either hosts or cooks.
