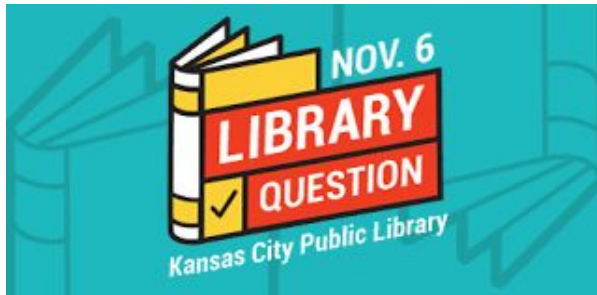


General Election - November 6
