



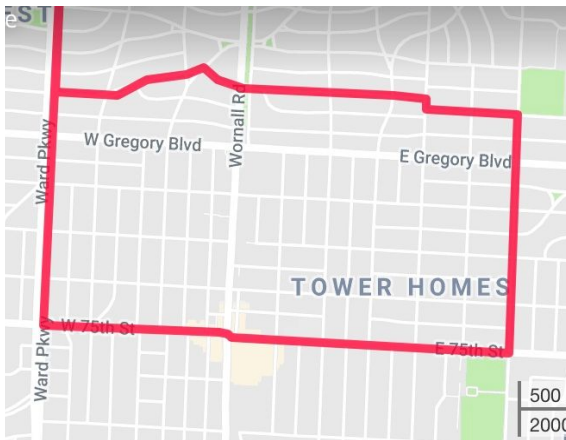

Kansas City Marathon on Saturday, October 20th! *See how it affects you!*

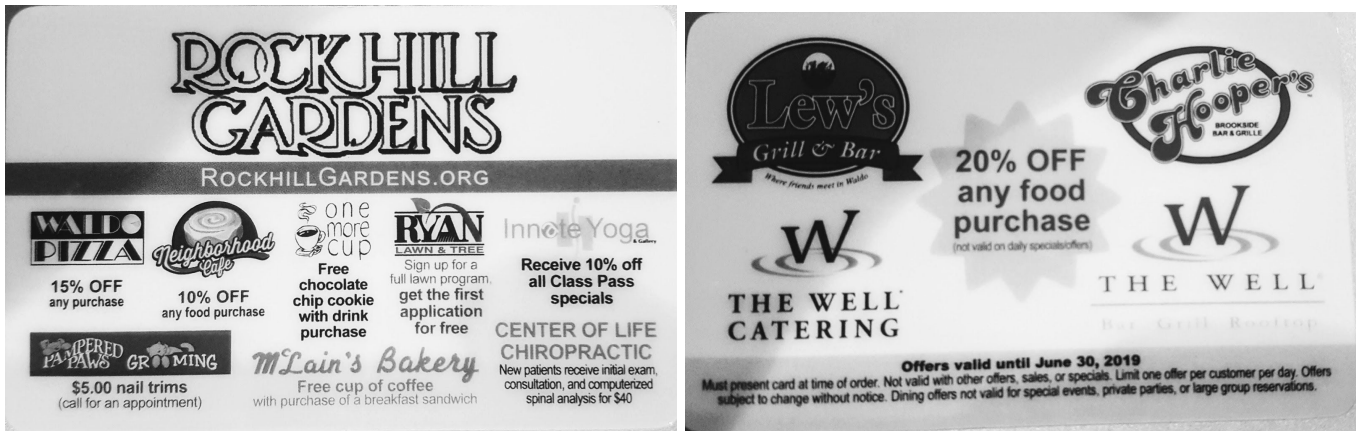
