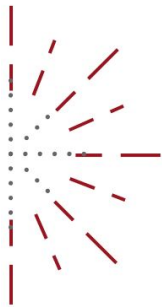

## Tips for dealing with a power outage

Kansas City had a major snow storm this past weekend with snow totals that topped 10 inches and many houses in RGNA losing power for over 24 hours. Here are a few things to prep for the rest of the season:

Prepare	During	After
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check your emergency kit and evacuation plan.</li> <li>• Have at least a half-tank of gas in your vehicle</li> <li>• Keep a hand-crank or battery-operated radio</li> <li>• Charge up devices (and batteries)</li> <li>• Learn how to manually release garage door</li> <li>• Notify power company on special medical equipment needs</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Report outage immediately - don't assume it's been reported</li> <li>• Use flashlights, not candles</li> <li>• Turn off and unplug unnecessary electrical equipment and appliances</li> <li>• Keep refrigerator closed as much as possible</li> <li>• Let faucets drip slightly</li> <li>• Use safe generator practices, no enclosed spaces</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Don't touch ANY downed electrical lines; report!</li> <li>• Reset digital clocks, alarms and other essentials</li> <li>• Throw away any food (particularly meat, poultry, fish, eggs and leftovers) that were in temps higher than 40° F (4° C) for 2+ hours</li> <li>• Reconnect garage door</li> </ul>
