DUMPSTER DAY - Saturday, May 11

Three bulk trash dumpsters, including one for leaf and brush, will be located on Cherry Street between 73rd Street and 73rd Terrace from 8 AM to 12 Noon (or when dumpsters are full).

The dumpsters are paid for from RGNA dues and are for the benefit of RGNA members. Non-members will be charged a fee (if space is available).

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- NO tires
- NO electronics – including TVs, computers/computer monitors
- NO hazardous materials - including paint pesticides, oil, or other chemicals, appliances with hazardous materials
- NO Business/Commercial waste

LEAF/BRUSH DUMPSTER:

- Only leaves and brush are allowed in the leaf and brush dumpster. No trash.
- Yard debris must be in a paper lawn bag or a cardboard box. No plastic bags.
- Tree limbs can be up to 10" in diameter and 6' in length.
