Fall Leaf Pick-Up - November 21

It's that time of year again. There is only one date this year so make sure to get your leaf and brush ready for pickup. Here are a few reminders:

- Place on the curb by 7:00 a.m. on the regularly-scheduled trash day.
- Use only paper lawn debris sacks. No plastic bags.
- Use masking tape to seal the sacks; No plastic or duct tape.
- No grass clippings. No trash.
- All branches must be bundled.
- Use twine or jute rope to tie bundles; do not use wire or plastic tape.

If sacks and bundles are not collected on the scheduled trash day, residents must call the 311 Call Center within 24 hours.

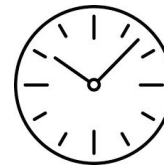
