Everyone should have received the mailer for renewing/joining RGNA. The annual dues remain \$35. Dues can be paid by mailing a check with the payment stub or paying online through the Homes Associations of Kansas City website – www.HA-KC.org. When you pay online, you do need the property ID number found on the renewal notice.

Renewal/New Membership Incentive Drawing

When you join or renew your membership by July 10*, you will be entered to win one of a number gift cards from local businesses. Focus will be on business that have supported RGNA and/or located in the surrounding area. Total number of gift cards is dependent on the dues payment received but our goal is to give away approximately 40-50 gift cards in the \$20/\$25 range.

Important Deadline Notifications for August 4th Ballot:

JUNE 22nd – In-person Absentee voting begins (KC Election Board at Union Station)

JULY 8th – Last Day to Register to Vote

JULY 22nd – Mail-in/Absentee ballot request must be received by Kansas City Board of Elections

AUGUST 3rd – In-Person Absentee voting ends

Special Notice on Mail-in/Absentee Ballot Requests

The Governor has signed into law 'no excuse' Mail-in voting for both the August 4th primary election and November 3rd general election. Voters that do not meet either exceptions for incapacitation or COVID-19 must have their ballot (not the ballot request) notarized before mailing. Please check the Facebook page or contact
