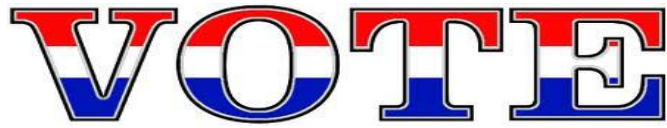
We will be happy to drop off a welcome to the neighborhood tote bag and provide information about the neighborhood.

Notary Night – Tuesday October 13th

RGNA resident Ronda Sprick will be providing free notary services for mail-in ballots at 612 E 73rd St from 5 – 7:30pm. Remember to bring your ballot/envelope, a mask and ID. Non-perishable food donations for the Waldo Tiny Pantry will also be gratefully accepted.

Mail-in Voting – Mail-in applications can be requested until October 21st. Mail-in ballots generally take a week or more to be received after requested and can only be returned by mail.

Absentee Voting – Deadline to request absentee ballot by mail is October 21st.

In person absentee voting at Union Station is available now through Monday November 2nd.

Satellite Absentee Voting locations will be open from October 13th – October 31st. Check kceb.org/absentee for locations and times.
