- Around 60% of household garbage can be composted instead of sent to a landfill. Composting creates rich soil instead of filling up a landfill and creating methane gas.

 - Compost Collective- Curbside composting and bin swap programs (Brookside Farmer's market is a swap location) (<u>www.compostcollectivekc.com</u>)
 - KC Can Compost- Register online and drop off your compost at one of their collection sites.
