Kansas City has partnered with nixle.com to provide text information notifications. Registration for the free service (text rates apply) can be done directly at nixle.com. The City plans to use this system to send out severe weather alerts, advisories on water main breaks, major road closures, city office closures or community messages such as trash delays. ## 75th and Wornall 'Ice House' Project

The building being constructed just east of 75th and Wornall is a new 5 story mixed use commercial and residential building. 4000 sq ft of the ground floor will be occupied by an optometrist office with another 800 sq ft available for another commercial tenant. 44 apartments will make up the remaining 4 floors of the building with a mix of studio, 1 and 2 bedroom apartments. While most recently the location of the Waldo Antiques store, the location was home to the Kansas City Ice Company from the 1920s - 1960s.
