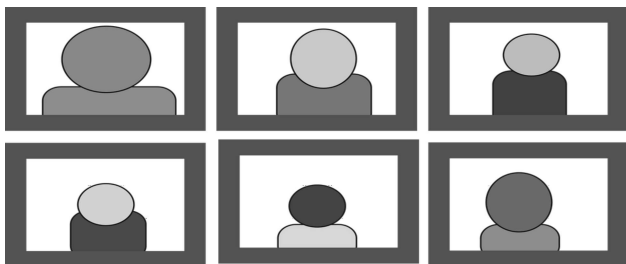

The RGNA Board has 4 positions that need to be filled for the upcoming 2021/2022 activity year. The positions are:
