### Details -

- RGNA Members only. You will be able to pay for a RGNA membership on-site (Cash/Check only; \$35)
- Goodwill donation truck will also be on-site
  - Goodwill is accepting donations of linens, housewares, accessories, books, and more.
- Reminders:
  - **NO:** tires; electronics or appliances including TVs, computers/computer monitors; hazardous materials including paint (paint cans must be completely washed out); pesticides, oil, or other chemicals;
  - **NO:** Business/Commercial/Contractor waste or debris
  - Do not bring cardboard or other items that can be recycled during weekly trash service
  - Yard Waste is limited to limbs and bagged leaves (<u>no grass clipping or use of plastic bags</u>)
